### **Can I visit my horse?**

You are welcome to come by and visit your horse during normal program office hours. We do suggest that you call ahead and check with the Equestrian Director about the best time to visit. As a sponsor, we encourage you to assist in the grooming and some of the general care of your horse. The exercising and training of the horses can only be done by Certified NARHA instructors or those who have passed the trainer evaluation. Do to insurance regulations, no one other than these people and HOH clients are allowed to ride the horses. You are invited to apply for the trainer evaluation.

### **General Horse Fund**

Donations can also be made to the general horse fund. This fund is for the general maintenance of the herd as well as special needs, feed or medical supplements, special training, the purchase of equipment such as tack or grooming tools, and any projects that will enhance the program and its horses.
